





Stuttering sub-group study

This study is investigating subgroups of people who stutter (past or present), based on family history, speech characteristics, personal experience of stuttering, and other health and medical conditions. Identifying subgroups of people who stutter with similar features will help us to better understand differences in stuttering such as why some people resolve naturally and some don't, or why some people respond to speech pathology treatments and others don't.
